Treasurer's Report

Andrew: Still fine on cash flow. Winter fundraiser [WPC] exceeded budget; helping offset recent costs

- Watching paid registration; under budget. Budgeted for 34 rowers
- Bus went up by \$50/day to \$450/day
- VASRA paid; hopefully they have updated their contact records; Linda to send them a message, seeking acknowledgement and confirming contact information
- Not paid: Crew council; having trouble connecting on POC. Linda to pursue
- Coach Mike has purchased for a few items out of pocket; booster reimbursed Coach Mike for the Vespoli expenditure
- Heidi suggested putting up a promotional post for specific donations we seek; 50th anniversary mugs in homepage slider currently

Registrar's Report — Mari

- Final paperwork for VASRA done. Debbie O'Rourke indicated she submitted the MEL.
- Chasing down payments from a few rowers. Mari pursuing.
- Coach Mike chasing down SRAA HIPAA forms for the lightweight rowers. When completed, forms go to Korey, to allow upload of weight data to SRAA website. Coach Rob has boys' forms; Coach Mike will handle girls' forms

Coaches Updates and Topics - Coach Mike

- Injured rowers; being careful to not negatively impact rowers and still have them active
- Parking passes question: In the past, VASRA provided 2-3 coaching passes as windshield stickers. But this year packet only has windshield hang tags (for the VASRA volunteers?). Passes for the coaches?
 - Per VASRA minutes: "Parking passes will not be distributed until all contact information provided; up to 5 parking passes." Linda to pursue.
- Launches: Replacement stickers are in for the green Jon boat; awaiting new stickers for the donated Barcroft launch and one of the V-hull launches.
- Launches: Need to have the registration numbers and letters on the bows; some are badly worn. Coach Mike to pursue with Bob Finley.
- Instead of VSRC day 1 we will go to Mathews. Coach Mike committed by email to the Mathews Regatta Director to attend on May 6th.
- Entries go in next Tuesday night for Polar Bear. Coaches routinely set regatta lineups on Tuesdays
- If rowers will be absent, need to know by Tuesday. Coach Mike registers the team's regatta entries on Tuesday night; VASRA produces a draft schedule Wednesday/Thursday which is typically shared with the coaches on Thursday.

- Trisch to look into Stuart Activities Fair at Glasgow; Coach Lexie to pursue with Mr. Garvey
- Summer Mini-Rowing Camp/Learn to Row Program (7th and 8th graders)
 - Let's set a date early so that we market and administer better (waivers, swim test, more)
 - Coach Mike to discuss with coaches. Green days a possibility; depends on availability of coaches
 - Need to name/frame to be able to offer to rising 8th graders as well as rising 9th graders

- Create a recruiting video; add a few interviews; play on a loop. Heidi to pursue

- Linda has application ready for review. Will circulate to Coach Rob and booster leadership
- Coach Rob and Linda to sit down with Principal Gros and possibly Mr. Brian Garvey to review proposal and seek suggestions for improvement on approach
 - Coach Mike suggested they take the opportunity to discuss with Principal Gros how to reach more kids at the school
- Next step is to create a plan for recruiting
- Program is more geared to community rowing as opposed to a high school; we're not a perfect fit for the program; seeking approach to make application successful
