TREASURER'S REPORT

- 1099 forms were filed late; fees may be assessed.
- Anne will work with Andrew Riester on filing taxes in April.
- Coaches' payments are all up to date.
- Coach Mike made insurance policy adjustments and the bill has been paid. (Note: We will need to make another adjustment for the new boat when it arrives. Some boat values may also be adjusted down prior to paying next year's bill.)

UNIFORMS & SPIRIT WEAR

- Linda will be putting in an order for uniforms to Sew Sporty. Deadline is Feb. 16. Heidi will text captains to remind all rowers to turn in their orders by Feb. 15. Linda will also order the gray t-shirts.
- Mari will ask Wayne at Sew Sporty if we should order "blank" uniforms now and embroider the new school name/logo later.
- In the meantime, we have gently worn uniforms that can also be put into rotation.
- The goal is to find a donor for new uniform costs next year (2018-2019).
- Boosters will be selling spirit wear during the preseason potluck dinner on March 23. No need to order more this year, though senior girls have asked for a tech shirt.
- Hoping to give back spirit wear duties to Sandy Fitzgerald next year.

TEAM ROSTER

- Lightweight assessments were done today (Feb. 13). All who were expected to qualify did qualify.
- Right now, we are looking at having women's senior quad, junior quad, LW 4 and novice 8. For men, looking to have 2 quads, but putting together boats has been a challenge. We may also need to have 2 single boats.
- Two rowers who received scholarship funds will not be rowing. Linda will ask if we can use this money for a half-scholarship that was requested tonight. Otherwise the Boosters will fund.
- Coach Mike has invited a physical therapist to educate the rowers about muscle groups and avoiding injury.
- A representative from Bucknell University would like to visit Stuart.

VASRA UPDATES

- Coach Mike submitted a count of 40 rowers to VASRA, as well as a list of regatta entries that Stuart will join this season.
- Boosters owe Catastrophe Medical check to VASRA.
- Coaches Mike and Rob need to sign the rules certification.
- Linda will check on other to-do's for VASRA.

EQUIPMENT AND LABOR

- The new boat, which was supposed to be delivered before the move to Occoquan, will be late. When the new boat does arrive, we will need space for the Jemo at the Occoquan boathouse. Options?
- Bob would like to get an automatic bilge pump for the launches. Cost is approximately \$300. Also would like to put lanyards on launch motors. Cost approximately \$50 - \$60 for all boats.
- Coach Mike needs 2 new batteries for cox boxes.
- Linda will replenish the safety kits.

- Bob has reserved June 30, 2018 at Lake Barcroft Beach 5 for the Alumni Event at a cost of \$100.
- Linda will bring the invitation and agenda for the Alumni Event at the next meeting.
