TREASURER'S REPORT

- As of 2/28/18, the Boosters have \$45,000 in our account. There is a total of \$10,000 in outstanding deposits.
- First payment of \$1,800 has been made to the bus company; another \$1,800 will be due.
- Boosters have paid a quarter of the total cost for the new boat. The balance will be paid when the boat is delivered.
- Anne has mailed refund check to OBC amounting to \$600+.
- CATmed bill has not been received yet; invoice is pending count for final team roster.
- Other upcoming expenses include \$1,000 for uniforms; approximately \$200 for gray t-shirts.
- Linda will compare this year's account balance with last year's to help Anne gauge the state of finances.

VASRA REQUIREMENTS

- Missing just one more MEL test and some rowing waivers. Mari will send out another reminder about forms and also send Coach Mike a list of rowers with missing paperwork.
- Dues have been paid to VASRA.
- Sandra will send a list of certified launch drivers to VASRA.
- We need a driver to fill one more slot (Championship regatta).
- Sandra will follow up with everyone who signed up for volunteer positions.

BOATS & MAINTENANCE

- The new 4 is being warehoused in Philadelphia while Shine On is repaired. The work is expected to be done next week. The team has a loaner boat while awaiting delivery.
- The Board has approved renting a single boat for \$250/month for 2 months. We will need an open rack for this second single at Sandy Run during regattas.
- Launch boats have current registration stickers.
- Oars are in good shape. Team has enough equipment for the number of rowers. Trailer lights are being fixed. Need to repair a couple of ERG monitors.
- Shell rental: Oakton Masters Rowing Club is interested in renting our boats in the offseason (both 4s and 8s). Coach Mike will consider. In the past, the team has earned \$7,000 in rental fees, but need to weigh revenue against cost of repairing any damages sustained.

- Coach Mike will also consider loaning out older boat(s) in goodwill to Mt. Vernon HS team that lost its boats to the storm.

- Preseason Dinner on 3/23/18: Heidi will provide the slideshow. Novices will receive their wrenches.
- Spring Fest on 4/13/18: Crew will have race-a-rower for \$1 to entice students to rowing. Winners will get gift card. Need volunteers to help the rowers set up the booth. Will ask Heidi to take photos at the event.
- Earth Day on 4/22/18: Raises funds for team by selling burgers, hot dogs, baked goods and doing race-a-rower. The Boosters will purchase the food except for the baked goods, which will be donated by parents.
- Regatta food sign-ups are all set and Sandra will monitor week to week.

RECRUITING

- Glasgow MS PE teachers have invited team of seniors and parents (including Spanish speakers) to introduce rowing in one of their PE classes again this spring. Merari will lead the effort; Linda will put her in touch with Glasgow teachers. Senior rowers Giselle and India will join.
