# Rower Responsibilities:

All members of the Justice Rowing team represent the team and Justice High School. As such they are held to the highest of standard regarding their conduct and sportsmanship while participating in practices, fundraising activities and regattas. Team members are expected to be respectful of those around them at all times and refrain from using profanity. Team members should take care of all equipment and uniforms at all times.

# Practices and Regattas:

- Team members are encouraged, not required, to participate in winter conditioning during the months of November, December and February if they are not participating in a winter sport.
- All members will be required to pass a swimming test. Help is provided for those who may need to improve swimming skills.
- Team members are expected to attend practices on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from February through May after school. Members selected to participate in post-season events will practice during June.
- Team members must be available for regattas on Saturdays during the season and those selected for post-season regattas. Failure to attend regattas impacts the whole boat not just the missing rower.

## Team Fundraising:

All team members will be expected to participate in the following events:

- 1. Car washes during fall and spring.
- 2. Bands at the Beach fundraiser at Lake Barcroft
- 3. Door-to-door wreaths, poinsettia, and coffee sales during the month of October.
- 4. Delivery of wreaths, poinsettia and coffee sales in December.
- 5. Earth Day at Bands at the Beach in April.
- 6. Manning team table at various school events throughout the year.
- 7. JHS Athletic Booster Spring Fling fundraiser
